Professor Nomalanga Mkhize is a historian based at the Nelson Mandela University in Gqeberha. She is the acting Director for the School of Governmental and Social Sciences. Her research interests are in African language historical literatures, vernacular historiography and 19th century Eastern Cape history.

Her current research interest is in Eastern Cape historiography and she takes a particular interest in the historiography of 19th century Xhosa writers. Her academic career spans more than a decade. Whilst pursuing this, she has also participated in education activism and other civil society initiatives in the Eastern Cape. She is a strong advocate for early mother-tongue reading and has collaborated in developing books and materials in African languages for children.

She has an MA in History from Rhodes University and a PhD in Sociology from the University of Cape Town.
